A RESOLUTION

1 RECOGNIZING that cruising Kearney Street is a community tradition that brings
2 neighborhoods together while promoting civic engagement and
3 encouraging tourism.

6 WHEREAS, cruising allows car enthusiasts to actively display classic vehicles
7 while simultaneously engaging with spectators in the community; and

9 WHEREAS, there are multiple events held in the City of Springfield that involve
10 cruising and draw tourists to the area; and

12 WHEREAS, the National Street Rod Association holds the Mid-America Street
13 Rod National event in the City of Springfield annually with approximately two-thousand
14 participants; and

16 WHEREAS, the Birthplace of Route 66 Festival Car Show and the Kilties Car
17 show are local events that also involve cruising; and

19 WHEREAS, these events are similar in nature to block parties and parades in
20 that they connect the community as neighbors.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
23 SPRINGFIELD as follows, that:

25 Section 1 – City Council recognizes that cruising is a community tradition that
26 brings neighborhoods together while promoting civic engagement and encouraging
27 tourism.

29 Section 2 - City Council directs staff to work with City Council and the community
30 to establish the promotional parameters associated with classic car cruising on Kearney
31 Street.

33 Section 3 - This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


